


The Nicene Godhead

beyond the boundaries of scripture

illustration of the Trinity taken from "My Catholic Faith" by Father Louis LaRavoire Morrow, p. 32. It has been a very popular catechism among Roman Catholics.



"And the Catholic Faith is this, that we worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in unity. Neither confounding the Persons, nor dividing the Substance. ... But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of The Holy Ghost is one, the glory equal, the majesty co-eternal. ... The Father is made of none, neither created, nor begotten. The Son is of

the Father alone: not made, nor created, but begotten. The Holy Ghost is of the Father and the Son: not made, nor created, nor begotten, but proceeding. ... And in this Trinity nothing is afore or after, nothing is greater or less, but the whole three Persons are co-eternal together, and co-equal" (From the Athanasian Creed).

This illustration shows why the **concept of the Trinity** is false – (here) the Son and the Holy Spirit have a beginning. Also, since they have the same substance, they are not eternal, instead they are strangely labeled as “co-eternal”. Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (supposedly) are all of one substance. The 3 “Persons” are really not persons, but “manifestations” of one mega-god.

Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are not “united”, but “triune”, not eternal, but “co-eternal”.

In the Trinity, the Son and Holy Spirit are not self-existent.

The Bible does not mention the Trinity, neither does the Spirit of Prophecy

The bible speaks of the Godhead (Acts 17:29, Romans 1:20, Colossians 2:9) and the Spirit of Prophecy in reference to the Godhead mentions the “Three Dignitaries of Heaven”, “Three Holiest Beings in Heaven”, “Three Great Powers of Heaven”, “Heavenly Trio”, “Three great Worthies of Heaven”, but the Trinity, not compatible with scripture, evidently for that reason was unworthy to have a place in the Spirit of Prophecy.

Then why are 7th Day Adventists worshipping the Trinity today? It has not always been that way. Looks like we have been duped to embrace this “abomination of desolation”. We seem to be in a state of paralysis and need to break loose from our careless indifference to cast off this monster of ungodliness. There was a reason why sister White did not give homage to the Trinity, she correctly recognized the concept to be unbiblical.
